Format Options

In the past Confirmands have presented their ideas in the form of a faith paper. This method is the preferred and perhaps easiest way of completing the Faith Reflection. However, we will not hinder the use of one's creativity. You may also choose to do:

- Children's book
- Series of posters

- Sermon
